

## **2025-2026 Legislative Priorities**

The Michigan Guardianship Association is the premier initiator for the advancement of legislative reform, guardianship licensure, education, and the promotion of best practices for the protection of vulnerable individuals.

- 1. Require State Licensure for all Professional Guardians and Conservators.
- 2. Secure Adequate Funding for the Work of Professional Guardians.
  - a. Increase Medicaid Rate (currently \$83 per month).
  - b. Provide Funding for No Fee Cases (currently \$0).
- 3. Combat Financial Abuse and the Exploitation of Vulnerable Individuals.
  - a. Require a conservator to either post a bond or use restricted bank accounts when the individual has liquid assets of \$25,000 or more.
  - b. Require a guardian to notify the Probate Court if they discover the individual has liquid assets in excess of \$25,000, if a conservator is not already in place.
  - c. All inventories submitted to the Probate Court shall include supporting documentation for all assets indicated on the inventory.
